HealthYes! continues national growth

Austin-based mobile medical screener [w/HealthYes!](#) marched forward with national expansion today, adding its second new service state in less than a month.

The company, founded in 2007, said Jan. 12 it was hiring a Phoenix-based team, and today Colorado was added to the bill. HealthYes! specializes in early detection, screening patients for heart disease, stroke, abdominal aortic aneurysm, peripheral artery disease, diabetes, liver disease and osteoporosis.

The Denver team was assembled in February and will begin screenings in Westminster, Colo., today. The five-person group will host about 20 public screenings per month in Denver and the surrounding area.

"Since the inception of HealthYes!, we have been focused on expanding throughout the United States. Denver is a strong next-step for our company," HealthYes! co-founder and CEO Dale W. Wood said.

He said the Denver team hopes to screen about 10,000 to 15,000 patients this year. HealthYes! will add more states this quarter and throughout the year, according to officials.

HealthYes!'s provides packaged screenings from \$140.
