## Medical screener HealthYes! coming to Colorado

Mobile medical screener [wHealthYes!](#) is expanding to the Denver area.

The Austin, Texas-based company, founded in 2007, specializes in early detection, screening patients for heart disease, stroke, abdominal aortic aneurysm, peripheral artery disease, diabetes, liver disease and osteoporosis.

The company has assembled a Denver-area team and planned to begin screenings in Westminster Thursday. The five-person group will host about 20 public screenings per month in Denver and the surrounding area.

“Since the inception of HealthYes!, we have been focused on expanding throughout the United States. Denver is a strong next step for our company,” HealthYes! co-founder and CEO Dale Wood said.

He said the Denver team hopes to screen about 10,000 to 15,000 patients this year. HealthYes! will add more states this quarter and throughout the year, according to officials.

HealthYes! provides packaged screenings from \$140. The company recently added a Phoenix-area team.
