

lauckgroup designs green HQ in Dallas

The Dallas-based interior architecture and design firm has won a contract to redesign the headquarters of Energy Future Holdings Corp. (EFH) in Dallas, US.

The contract involves redesigning the 130,000 square feet corporate headquarters of EFH located at Energy Plaza, in downtown Dallas. Post completion, the facility will be one of the most sustainable corporate headquarter locations in Dallas and hold a US Green Building Council's LEED for Commercial Interiors (CI) designation.

Eco-friendly components have been used throughout the new space, including high-efficiency lighting and sustainable materials. Broader access to daylight, more teaming spaces for collaboration and leading-edge technology have also been integrated into the work environment.

Brigitte Preston, design principal of lauckgroup, says that they have been working to reuse existing materials, while creating a modern, light-filled work environment for EFH. He adds that their design seeks to blend sustainability, technology and modern design to create a functional and multipurpose workplace.

The new headquarters of EFH is expected to reach completion by June 2009.

EFH, formerly known as TXU Corp., is a Dallas-based privately held energy company with a portfolio of competitive and regulated energy subsidiaries.
